SEWS ON ALL TYPES & WEIGHTS	 FABRICS: Woven Medium chino and Stretch Light Tricot SELECT: Straight stitch (1) on stitch selection dial. Stitch length 2.5. Stitch width 5. USE: Presser Foot A SHOW: Sewing Guide Reference Chart. SEW: Fold both fabrics in half (right sides together). Sew along the fold, one right after the other, using %" (15 mm) seam allowance. FABRIC: Woven Heavy denim SELECT: Stitch length 3 USE: Presser Foot A SEW: Fold denim in half, wrong sides together. Sew along the fold using %" (15 mm) seam allowance. Fold the seam to one side. Topstitch down along the edge of the fold. Fold up the bottom raw edge twice to form a hem. Sew the hem in place. 	 When you select a stitch, you are ready to sew. PERFECT REPEATING BUTTONHOLES	 SHOW: Buttonhole Samples on different types of fabrics. FABRIC: Woven Medium chino and stabilizer SELECT: Buttonhole on the stitch selection dial. Stitch length is set at the buttonhole setting. Stitch width 5. Thread tension 4-5. USE: R Foot (Automatic Buttonhole foot) SEW: Fold the fabric in half with a piece of stabilizer between the layers. Turn the hand wheel toward you to raise the needle to the highest position. Slide the button holder to the back. Place the button holder forward until it holds the button tightly. Position the fabric under the presser foot. Buttonholes are sewn from front to back. Lower the buttonhole lever. Push it back until it clicks into place. Holding the thread tail, start sewing. To sew the next buttonhole, turn the stitch selection dial to the curved arrow and then back to the buttonhole. When finished, push the buttonhole lever up. 	 The automatic buttonhole foot can hold a button up to 2.5 cm (1"). Adjust the stitch length dial within the buttonhole range to alter density for different types and weights of fabrics. Buttonholes can also be done manually with the "C" foot.
PERFECTLY FABRIC FEEDING	Before sewing, talk about the HUSQVARNA VIKING [®] feeding system.	 HUSQVARNA VIKING[®] sewing machines have diamond-point feed teeth. They move fabric evenly, and fabric doesn't get caught. HUSQVARNA VIKING[®] sewing machines have a box-feed system. Feed teeth move straight up, back, and down for the most efficient feeding of your project.

USE: Presser Foot B SHOW: Sewing Guide Reference Chart SEW: Cut a small neckline in the sweatshirt fleece. Fold the ribbing in half lengthwise, stretch to fit the neckline curve in the fleece. Sew near the fabric edge, creating a neckline. 	 Sew the seam and overcast the edge at the same time to prevent raveling. Create a seam that will stretch on knit fabrics. Adjustable presser foot pressure makes it easy to accommodate all thicknesses and weights of fabric.
EASY BLIND HEM V:V	 FABRIC: Woven Medium wool SELECT: Stitch length 1.5 on the stitch length dial. Select Blind hem stitch (5) on the stitch selection dial. Stitch width 5. USE: Presser Foot D. Turn the orange dial on Presser Foot D until the wide stitch of the blind hem barely catches fabric fold. SEW: Fold up the hem on the wool. Keep the fold of fabric along the inner edge of the right toe of foot. 	 With the perfectly-engineered blind hem foot, your HUSQVARNA VIKING[®] EDEN ROSE[™] 250M sews a beautiful blind hem. "Fine tune" the blind hem width for different types of fabrics. Move Presser Foot D guide from left to right as needed by turning the orange dial on the presser foot.
MULTIPLE NEEDLE POSITIONS	 FABRIC: Woven Medium chino SELECT: Straight stitch (1) on the stitch selection dial. Stitch length 2.5. Stitch width 5. USE: Presser Foot A SEW: Fold fabric in half and place along the long edge of foot. Sew a seam. Adjust the needle position by adjusting stitch width to 0. Sew another seam along the same fold. Stitch width 0. USE: Presser Foot B SEW: Draw a monogram letter on the fabric using water soluble marker. Increase stitch width slowly toward 5 as you sew to form a satin stitch.
